## Dave Bennett Memorial / Conway Sportsman's Club Scholarship

### **Dave Bennett Memorial Scholarship**

The Dave Bennett Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to any graduating Conway Senior, or member of the family that is in good standing with the club. The amount of the scholarship shall be equal to the interest received from the principle in the scholarship fund in increments of twenty-five dollars with the minimum scholarship amount of one hundred dollars.

The Conway Sportsman's Club Inc. Scholarship policy will also apply to this scholarship fund.

### Conway Sportsman's Club Inc. Scholarship Policy

#### Conway Sportsman's Club scholarship will be:

Awarded on the basis of information provided in the Scholarship Application. Late Applications will not be considered for awards unless the tardiness is the result of the Committee failure.

Primary consideration will be given to a student's community/ school involvement (civic responsibility), academic standing, and work history.

Secondary consideration will be given to a student's post-graduation plans (cost of school, etc.) and family financial considerations.

#### CONWAY SPORTSMAN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Conway Sportsman's Club Scholarship is awarded to any graduating Conway Senior or member of the family that is in good standing with the club, regardless of post graduate plans. Seniors must complete an application to be eligible for an award. The distribution of funds will be determined based on the point system described below. The points are the maximum attainable in each category:


